

CLUB PRESIDENT'S AWARD FOR OUTSTANDING ORGANIZATION,
ADMINISTRATION AND LEADERSHIP

Presented and passed at Spring Board Meeting April 3, 2001

Who may apply? The Executive Committee of any Member Club of the Federated Garden Clubs of Vermont. The Application must be in the hands of the Awards Chairman by the first day of April.

Who would qualify as a nominee? Any President, Co-President or immediate Past President or immediate Past Co-President who has served for at least one year.

Who would compose the Selection Committee? The three District Directors chaired by the FGCV Awards Chairman.

The FGCV Awards Chairman would be responsible for the recipient's name to be engraved on the Award each year.

How to apply? Write a statement, one page or less, stipulating how your nominee has met the following criteria and send to the FGCV Awards Chairman by April 1st.

CRITERIA - suggested guidelines

1. Organization - Have the elected and appointed members of your Club been properly trained for leadership by using the NGC Training Packet?
2. Administration - Were Goals set? Were meetings run efficiently? Were meetings conducted in a fair way? Were meetings productive? Was this a team effort?
3. Leadership - If Goals were set, were they fulfilled? Were your Club By-Laws carried out properly? Was your Club represented at FGCV Board of Directors Meetings and annual Meetings? Was your Club represented at New England Region Annual Meetings? Did your Club participate in the State Project? Did your Club participate in the National Garden Clubs National Project? Did your Club apply for FGCV, NER and NGC Awards?

THE AWARD WILL BE A PEWTER PLATE WITH THE INSCRIPTION "CLUB PRESIDENT'S AWARD FOR OUTSTANDING ORGANIZATION, ADMINISTRATION AND LEADERSHIP" TO BE ENGRAVED WITH RECIPIENT'S NAME AND PASSED ON TO THE NEXT RECIPIENT.
